Sanford Residents are encouraged to do their part to keep motor oil filters, wooden pallets and plastic bottles out of landfills.

Residents should recycle their **BOTTLES** in with their current **CITY** curbside recycling.

ALL recyclable items are picked up in **GREEN** 18-gallon bins (provided by Waste Management), on the same day as your trash pick up.



City residents should place your **WOODEN PALLETS** beside limbs at curbside for pickup.

Commercial business establishments should contact their private solid waste haulers for disposal options.

Oil filters, pallets and plastic bottles join a list of previously banned materials:

- Aluminum cans
- Antifreeze
- Appliances
- Beverage containers from ABC permitted facilities
- Lead-Acid batteries
- Motor oil
- Oyster shells
- Yard waste
- Scrap tires
